 Beth means house, interiority.



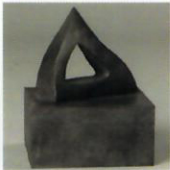
Mem is inspired by the phoenician letter (𐤃).

 Mem means water, movement.

 Nun means fish, snake, hidden.

 Hé means window, breath, life.

 (**F, U, V, W, Y**) in Latin, (**و**) in Arabic.
 Waw means nail, hook, secure.



Peh is inspired by the phoenician letter (𐤋).
 (**P**) in Latin, (**ف**) in Arabic.
 Peh means mouth, word, opening.



Zayin is inspired by the phoenician letter (𐤌).
 (**Z**) in Latin, (**ز**) in Arabic.
 Zayin means weapon, conflict.



Sadhe is inspired by the phoenician letter (𐤍).
 (**S**) in Latin, (**ص, ض**) in Arabic.
 Sadhe means hook, capture.

 Heth means wall, fence, obstacle.
